### **150 SCH**

Normally a student will graduate with 128 SCH. Additional SCH can be obtained by taking courses during winter/summer terms, overloads during semesters or by staying additional semester(s). The number of SCH awarded to a student while they are at St. Norbert College will be noted on their transcript.

### **30 SCH in Accounting**

This requirement is fulfilled by obtaining a major in Accounting at St. Norbert College along with taking one 2 credit accounting elective course.

### **Research and Analysis in Accounting (2 SCH)**

At St. Norbert College, by completing the required accounting courses for an accounting major, the required 2 SCH in Research and Analysis in Accounting will be obtained.

Research and Analysis in Accounting within the Accounting Department at St. Norbert College is defined as the integration of information obtained from various sources such as the FASB codification, auditing standards and the IRS tax code along with the interpretation and analysis of data in order reach an informed conclusion.

### **Business Communication (2 SCH)**

Students at St. Norbert College will have completed .75 SCH of business communication by taking the required accounting courses for a major in accounting. Students majoring in accounting at St. Norbert College also must complete the following business courses which contain the business communication requirement:

Computer Applications in Business - BUAD 142	.25 SCH
Foundations of Management – BUAD 230	.25 SCH
Strategic Management Seminar – BUAD 485	.75 SCH

Therefore, through the required accounting and business courses to obtain an accounting major at St. Norbert College, the required 2 SCH in business communication will be obtained.

Business Communication at St. Norbert College is defined as the learning and application of appropriate communication methods found in business settings. The communications can be in written and/or oral form.

### **Business Ethics (3 SCH)**

Students at St. Norbert College will have completed 2 SCH of business ethics by taking the required accounting courses for a major in accounting. Students majoring in accounting at St. Norbert College also must complete the following business courses which contain the business ethics requirement:

Computer Applications in Business - BUAD 142	.25 SCH
Foundations of Management – BUAD 230	.25 SCH
Strategic Management Seminar – BUAD 485	.25 SCH
Corporate Finance – BUAD 350	.25 SCH

Therefore, through the required accounting and business courses to obtain an accounting major at St. Norbert College, the required 3 SCH in business ethics will be obtained.

Business Ethics at St. Norbert College is defined as both theoretical and case discussion and analysis of situations with uncertain moral consequences. The purpose is to better equip students to analyze possible courses of action in moral situations they may be encounter during their careers.
